SUBJECT: Records About Drug Experimentation

REFERENCE: Memo dtd 3 Oct 78 to D/L fm DDA, same subj

1. The reference requested OL certification that complete searches had been made for any records pertaining to Agency drug testing programs plus an estimate of the probability that further records might be in OL files but not uncovered. In an initial oral response, EO/OL assured [REDACTED], DDA Staff, that OL had, in fact, performed extensive searches and that the probability of further records being uncovered was slim. This estimate has proved to be in error. The recent records review program conducted at the record center has revealed copies of correspondence pertaining to drug-related contracting by [REDACTED]. It is also apparent that previous drug-related paper searches have been functionally directed rather than all-encompassing.

2. As noted above, OL has uncovered some memoranda pertaining to drug-related contracts. Additionally, OL is now directing a complete file search by all components to insure that no additional documents are available. This search will require up to 2 weeks, and a final conclusive position as requested in the referent should be available not later than 27 October. Copies of the documents recently uncovered are attached.
