[REDACTED] is currently the [REDACTED], and as a Special Agent for the former Federal Bureau of Narcotics was assigned to the San Francisco office between January 1958 and November 1966. From San Francisco, I interviewed [REDACTED] on the telephone on Tuesday, March 27, 1979, in his office [REDACTED] stated that he was fully aware of the undercover safe houses in San Francisco; however, at that time had absolutely no knowledge of any CIA involvement. He said that to his knowledge the safe houses located on Chestnut Street, Mill Valley and the Plantation Inn, were used solely for undercover narcotic investigations and parties. He personally had never used either of the safe houses in an undercover capacity. [REDACTED] stated he had absolutely no knowledge of any drugging experiments in the safe houses and conversely had no knowledge of the identity of anyone who may have been unwittingly drugged. [REDACTED] stated that Ira Feldman was heavily involved in the operations of the safe houses and that anyone would be able to tell us what transpired in the safe houses it would be Feldman.
