I have been in contact with the mentioned in the entry for She reported that three women were involved in the events of that evening. She reports the three women were herself, Mrs. White, and a third woman she did not know well and whose name she could not recall. She did recall that the third woman present had a baby. Since the three women exhibited similar reactions during the party, assumes they were all given the same thing. The reports that her bad trip started after she had returned home.

It was revealed in 1977 that the Central Intelligence Agency had secretly supported George White as a "consultant" to test LSD on unwitting subjects. In August 1977 the Director of CIA made a commitment to the Congress to make every effort to identify, locate, and inform as many unwitting test subjects as possible of their involvement in the program. In keeping with this commitment we now inform you that the limited evidence and testimony available suggests that your recently deceased may have been given LSD without her knowledge and informed consent.

We very much want to bring this project of informing possible test subjects of their unwitting participation to a satisfactory and speedy conclusion. Should you be able to help identify, or give information which would help to locate, any of the persons mentioned in the enclosed
